1. Who are we?

Pathé is a French leading company in the European movie industry, and provides production, distribution and operation services in this field.

Pathé Films publishes and manages the Website www.notredameonfire.org.

2. Who is responsible for processing your Data?

The Data Controller is Pathé Films, a simplified joint stock company having a registered capital of € 5,545,420, registered with the Paris Trade & Companies Registry under number 780 077 921, with registered offices located at 2 rue Lamennais 75008 Paris (France), represented by Ardavan Safaee, President.



3. What types of Data do we collect?

We collect different types of information about you:

- Automatically, when you access the Website: your IP address, technical information about your browser and terminal as well as navigation Data;
- When you upload your film or video file to the Website via the contact form available on the home page of the Website: your surname, first name, e-mail address, postal address and telephone number. We keep your Data if your film or video file is selected by the Film Production team, and we may need to retain Data on the history of our exchanges in order to better respond, only for as long as our interaction makes this necessary.

4. Why do we process your Data and for what purpose(s)?

We use and process your Data for several reasons:

- Being able to contact you if your film or video file has been selected and to prepare an agreement for the transfer of your intellectual property rights to Pathé;
- Carrying out statistical surveys, notably to better meet your expectations;
- Improving the Website and your navigation experience.

5. Are you required to provide us with your Data?

There is no legal obligation for you to provide us with information about yourself. However, we cannot contact you if you do not provide us with the information required as compulsory on our contact form.

You remain free to disclose to us the Data identified as optional, which we collect to enable us to improve the Website or your navigation experience.

6. How do we obtain your consent?

We only collect, process and use your Data with your clear, explicit and unequivocal consent.

This is how we obtain your consent:

- when you accept web browser cookies as per the provisions of article 8 of this Privacy Policy and Cookies Policy,
- when you use the contact form to upload your film or video file.

7. How long will your Data be kept?

Your Data is kept for the time necessary to contact you and sign an agreement with you for transferring your intellectual property rights on your film or video file to Pathé. We make sure that the retention period is reasonable in relation to the purpose of the Data collection.

Cookies managed by Pathé are kept for up to thirteen months unless you withdraw your consent through the "[Set your cookies](#)" section on the Website.

Pathé complies with the retention periods imposed by applicable laws and regulations. If we no longer require your Data to contact you or to respond to an enquiry, your Data will be deleted or archived in anonymised or pseudonymised form in compliance with applicable regulations.

8. Cookies

When you visit our Website, cookies may be placed and read in the active browser on your computer or terminal.



We use these cookies to collect Data:

- to help you navigate our Website;
- to track your navigation path and measure our audience.

The maximum retention period for cookies is 13 (thirteen) months from the time they are placed on your browser or terminal. After the expiry of this period, your consent will be required again. At any time, you can modify your consent or your refusal by configuring your internet browser or your terminal accordingly as indicated below or by clicking on the "[Set your cookies](#)" section on the Website. The refusal of certain cookies may disrupt the User's browsing on the Website and the use of certain services.

9. Who receives your Data?

As the Data controller, Pathé is the recipient of your Data collected through the Website.

Our partners may also be recipients of some of your Data that they collect through the use of cookies appearing on your browser in accordance with their privacy policy and/or their cookies policy as referenced at the links above. In this case, our partners are respectively Data controller for processing the Data thus collected.

10. Who do we share your Data with?

We make sure that our subcontractors provide serious guarantees regarding the implementation of security and confidentiality measures for the Data to which they have access while performing their services as defined by the applicable regulations.

We share your Data with external service providers who help us manage the services we provide, notably when viewing videos using YouTube, during the Website maintenance, for security, IT assistance and for hosting the Website. The intervention of each of these external service providers is strictly limited to the service they perform for us and is in compliance with the applicable regulations.

11. To which countries do we transfer your Data?

We store your Data within the European Union territory.

The maintenance of the Website is performed within France.

Some of our service providers may have access to your Data when using Google Analytics and when maintaining the infrastructure required to host the Website. In this case, some of your Data may be transferred outside the European Union territory for statistical and maintenance purposes by our service providers.

12. What measures are implemented to guarantee the security of your Data?

We implement appropriate technical and organisational measures to guarantee a level of security for your Data that responds to the risks of Data loss, access, modification, alteration, unauthorised disclosure or destruction.

Access to your Data is strictly limited and reserved for Pathé employees authorised to manage relationships with Users for the purpose of contacting them and drafting an agreement for transferring your intellectual property rights to Pathé and/or authorised to manage Users' requests at notredamebrule@pathe.com.

In compliance with applicable regulations, Pathé implements physical and electronic backup procedures for Data collected on the Website.

Be aware that Pathé has no control over the risks inherent to Internet usage and, in particular, the occurrence of specific events that could lead to the loss of Data or breach the confidentiality of Data transiting through the Website.

Pathé cannot be held liable in the event that access to the Website is interrupted for reasons of force majeure or events beyond its control.

When required by applicable regulations, any security and/or confidentiality breach affecting your Data will be communicated to you and to the CNIL (National Commission for Information Technology and Civil Liberties) as promptly as possible.



13. What are your rights and how do you exercise them?

13.1 Your rights

As a Data subject, you have a right of access to your Data, a right to rectify your Data when they are inaccurate, a right to delete your Data, a right to refuse and limit the processing of your Data, and a right to the portability of your Data, i.e. the right to receive the Data that you have communicated to us in a structured, commonly used and computer-readable format and to forward them to another Data Controller.

13.2 How do you exercise your rights?

To process your request efficiently, please provide us with your first and last name, e-mail address and any other information necessary to confirm your identity and enable us to process your request. In your request, you will also need to specify whether you wish to receive the reply by post or electronically. If you do not specify a preference, we will reply to you electronically if you have given us your e-mail address.

We will reply to you as soon as possible and in any event within one month of receipt of your request, which may be extended by a further month depending on the request.
